**Policy on Swine Flu (H1N1)

PLEASE READ

With so much media attention, we have received a number of questions and concerns regarding the potential for an outbreak of the Swine Influenza. It is our intent to clarify our clinics' policy and our formal recommendations regarding this concern.

In order to protect all our patients and staff, we would appreciate your cooperation in minimizing possible exposure and spreading of the Swine Influenza (H1N1) in our clinics and community.

Please do NOT visit either clinic if you are presenting any of the following symptoms: fever, cough, runny or stuffy nose, chills, headache, sore throat, muscle aches, fatigue, vomiting or diarrhea. . If you are in need of medical care for complications of Swine Influenza or present with any of the symptoms listed below, we recommend treatment at a facility equipped to assist you. Recommended facilities could include Urgent Care Facilities, Emergency Rooms, or Physician's Offices equipped to test for H1N1. In order to accurately test for H1N1, a special test must be utilized. Cayle Clinic, PC is NOT equipped to test for this virus. We recommend that if you are in need of medical support to call any office/facility in advance to verify that they possess the necessary testing materials.

Should you need to cancel or reschedule an appointment at Cayle Clinic or CSI of MI due to this illness, there will be no charge or penalty assessed. However, we would appreciate notification at your earliest convenience. Please be advised that our front office staff have been informed to notify management should any person enter into the lobby and/or clinic area with the below symptoms. If you are presenting with any of these symptoms, we will politely ask that you return home to limit exposure as advised by the Centers for Disease Control (CDC) and the Macomb County Health Department.
